10. What was of most benefit to you on this conference?

Nearly every response referred to Sharing Ideas, Networking and meeting colleagues (seeing old friends & making new). Many also said they were inspired by hearing about others' work, and appreciated the time to think, reflect, connect and have conversations with others in similar work environments.

11. What might you do differently as a result of having attended?

Several answers stated a review or revamp of the <u>type</u> of activities and tours they offer – making them more interactive and/or more for SEND, but mostly had gathered so many ideas they'd need time to think these through and share with others back at their setting!

A number were intrigued by the Contested Heritage talk and will look at their monuments and consider how to approach their interpretation for visitors. Some will take back messages about donations, funding and a new approach to expand and develop resources.

12. What specific improvements to a residential conference would you suggest?

It was heartening to read references about us responding to feedback from last year – eg. Providing breaks/down time in the programme, allowing time to explore the host cathedral and to discuss what they'd experienced with others after sessions. There were several requests for next time to be in a warmer building *despite our many reminders that it will be cold!* One person suggested a dance after the dinner!

13. Any themes that you would value in future conferences (be they online or residential)? No two answers were the same here, so below are just a few of the responses.

- Working with volunteers & volunteer training
- Contested Heritage / inclusion & interfaith histories
- Not pilgrimage (again!)
- Digital / tech info
- Engaging with older students (KS3 5)
- Adjacency
- Working across departments among the cathedral staff music, worship, learning & events "Connecting the Dots"

The overall average mark out of 10 for the conference was 9.3 (last year it was 8.6). 🙂
